It is up to all of us to fulfil our commitment by wearing at all times:

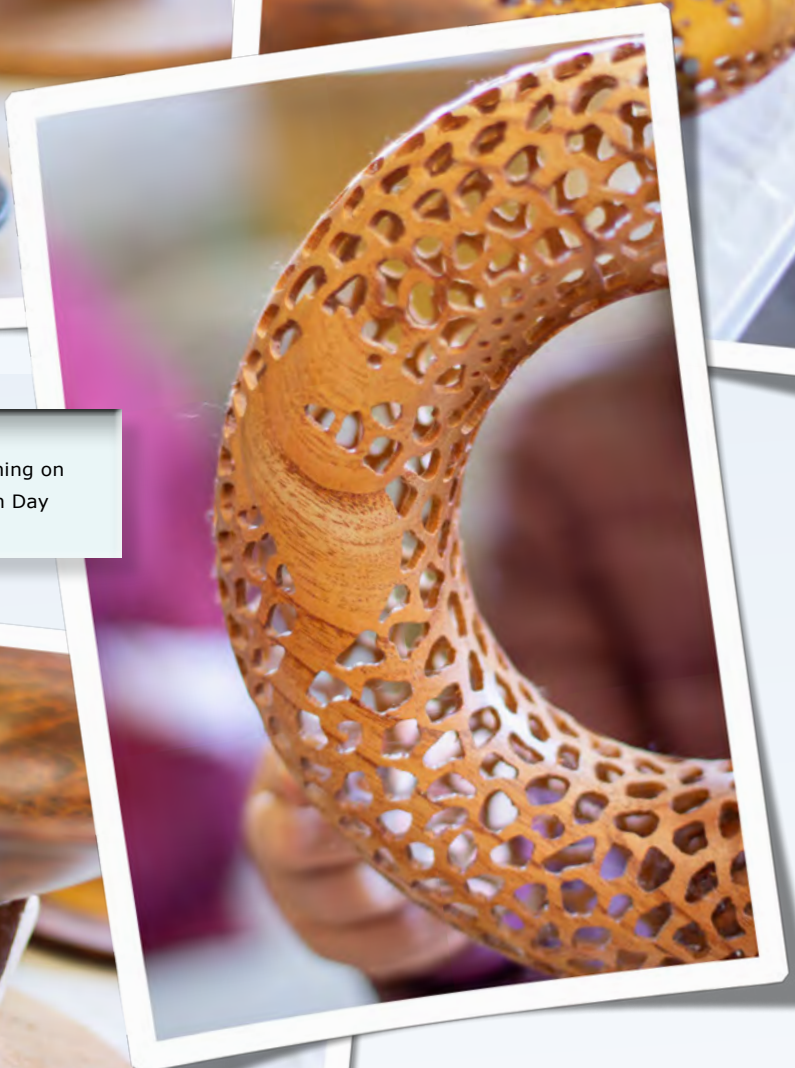
- DUST MASKS.
